\*\*Candidates have 4 attempts to pass the skills and written exams. The first **skills** exam attempt is included in the class fee. If additional attempts are needed, a \$100 exam fee is assessed for each attempt and must be scheduled. The **written** exam administered through Credentia is \$55 per attempt – no attempts are included with the class.
