

# PATH TO CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT (NAC) CREDENTIAL

Timeline and steps to earn the WA NAC credential within a Wenatchee Valley College CNA FastTrack, CNA Bridge, or NURS 100 class.

## APPLY FOR NAC

Apply for NAC credential with WA DOH.  
**At class start.**

[doh.wa.gov/licenses-permits-and-certificates/professions-new-renew-or-update/nursing-assistant](https://doh.wa.gov/licenses-permits-and-certificates/professions-new-renew-or-update/nursing-assistant)

\$85 application fee. Keep and make note of your credential number. Application will be in "pending" status.

## 80% PASSING

Complete classroom and clinical instruction with minimum 80%.

Complete coursework up to clinicals with 80% or better to advance to clinicals. All coursework including clinicals passed at 80% or better to take the skills exam.

## SKILLS EXAM

First attempt is included with the class.

**Last scheduled class day.**  
**NAC credential number required.**

Four attempts are allowed on different dates. Attempts 2-4 cost \$100 each. If not passed after four attempts, this course or an equivalent must be retaken to re-test. No course refunds.

## PASS COURSE

The course is completed and passed upon achieving a passing score on the skills exam.

Certificate of Completion issued.

## WRITTEN EXAM

- **Create a Credentia account.**  
*Can be completed anytime.*
- **Register for the written exam.**  
*After passing the skills exam.*

Four attempts are allowed (\$55 each). If not passed after 4 attempts, this course or an equivalent must be retaken to re-test. No course refunds.
